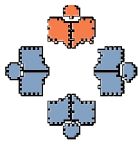

Training Policies

- All workshops require registration that will be accepted on a first come first serve basis.
- All workshops requiring payment will be accepted in the form of **money order** only. No personal checks or cash will be accepted. Payments are non-refundable & non-transferrable.
- Reminder calls will be made via an automated system, but ultimately participants should keep track of each workshop they register for.
- Late Arrivals—A fifteen (15) minute grace period will be given at all training sessions. This grace period begins at the advertised start time. Participants will not be allowed in the training after the 15-minute grace period.
- Early departures—In order to receive a training certificate, participants must remain until the end of the training. Unreasonable time spent out from the workshop will result in the loss of a training certificate and may result in removal from the workshop. If you must handle an emergency, please notify the facilitator or partner staff and dismiss yourself from the workshop.
- Children are not permitted at workshop sessions.
- All cell phones must be placed on vibrate prior to the start of the workshop. Participants needing to attend to phone calls should excuse themselves from the workshop.
- If you register for a series training, you must attend all sessions in order to receive credit. No partial credit will be given.
- Standby participants will only be accepted if space allows; you are not guaranteed entrance into a training as a standby.

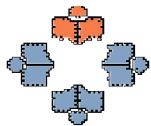
